



Hi Everyone

After reviewing the survey in its entirety, I have made the decision to withdraw from any ongoing and future involvement with CVE initiatives in Boston. I first became involved with this project at a time when I had full faith in the direction that the team was headed, and the leadership of the administration guiding this important work. In recent weeks I have grown increasingly uncomfortable with the intentions of the program. I look

forward to continuing to partner with our local law enforcement and community leaders to find ways to combat violence in our neighborhoods and across the country, but I cannot in good conscience continue to support any local partnerships with CVE initiatives under the Trump administration. I'd like to remind those still involved with the program that extremism, radicalization, and violence exists across cultures, religions. and ethnicities - focusing efforts specifically on one subgroup will ultimately create deeper divisions in our fractured society, doing more harm than good.

BOSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

Enhancing Trust - Building on the legacy of Community Policing in Boston

The Boston Police Department has been a leader in Community Policing nationally for over 20 years. Created in the early 1990's with the core concepts of partnership, prevention and problem-solving; the men and women of the BPD have expanded and evolved their efforts in keeping with this philosophy of Community Policing. Today the BPD has extensive partnerships and collaborations in each of the eleven districts, in addition to many citywide programs.

Under the leadership of Mayor Walsh and Commissioner Evans, the BPD is building on this strong foundation to push the boundaries further, prioritizing relationships with youth and the community as the key to solidifying trust in our neighborhoods. This starts with positive interactions on the streets and in school classrooms; includes proactive prevention and diversion for at-risk youth and their families; and provides pathways away from violence for those who are ready to make a change.

The BPD has strong partnerships and collaborations with many other agencies, non-profits, and community based programs. From the vast array of year-round district activities with youth to the support for families of homicide victims and victims of domestic violence; from the home visits and referrals of at-risk youth to social workers to the youth dialogues with community partners; from Coffee with a Cop to flashlight walks with residents; from Shop with a Cop to the Academy training officers to better interact with youth; and from reentry programs for returning offenders to school safety days with special needs populations; the BPD is working every day to build and strengthen relationships with the community.

The following is a list of some of the BPD's best practices in community outreach and engagement, as well as partnerships to assist at-risk youth and families and prevent violence.

Outreach and Intervention:

- YouthConnect: YouthConnect is a nationally recognized partnership between the BPD and the Boys & Girls Clubs formed in 1996 that places social workers in police stations with front-line officers. Understanding that arrest will not provide youth with the social services they need, police officers instead make referrals to the in-house district social workers. Currently the program covers Roxbury, Mattapan, Dorchester, Jamaica Plain and the South End; with additional citywide coverage through Youth Violence Strike Force (gang unit) and School Police Unit social workers.
- EPIC Enhancing Potential Inspiring Change new program run by YouthConnect and funded by John Hancock, to serve approximately 50 at-risk 11-14 year olds (and their families) per year. The focus of the program will be to reduce risky behaviors to increase positive decision-making skills, while creating opportunities to increase self-awareness and confidence through the acquisition of leadership and work-readiness skills. EPIC started in early July, with some kids attending Camp Harbor View or Mattapan Teen Center. Case management for the EPIC families also began at this time, with all families having at least an initial home visit to start discussing needed supports for the family. Bi-weekly career awareness and leadership workshops took place starting in late September at the six designated schools and will continue throughout the 2015-2016 school year.
- Operation Homefront: This is a collaboration between the BPD School Police Unit, MBTA Police, School Safety, Social Service Agencies and Faith Based organizations that addresses the belief that the family is the first line of defense against gang activity, truancy, etc. Police/clergy home visits are performed for youth at-risk of gang involvement. They are initiated on a school-by-school basis when a serious or concerning incident occurs or there is an escalating level of issues that may adversely affect school safety. This initiative provides a crucial link to parents, with various resources for parents, students and teachers to leverage in preventing problems for students.
- Increased impact of BPD School Police Unit: The Boston Police Department increased the
 number of officers in the School Police Unit in order to expand presence into elementary schools
 to engage in positive relationships and dialogues between students and police starting in first
 grade.
- Operation Exit Trades Pre-Apprenticeship Program is designed as an intensive training program to prepare participants for entry into an apprenticeship in the building trades. Through Career Readiness and Occupational Skills Training, encompassing classroom, peer to peer mentorship and hands-on learning experiences, Operation Exit will provide the knowledge and skills required for participants to apply for and enter into a state-registered Building Trades apprenticeship program. In addition, coordinated case management and placement services will be provided to assist participants in achieving their career goals. Partnership with Mayor's Public Safety Initiative and YOU Boston.

- Homicide Outreach Program: The BPD Homicide Unit has provided outreach and support to the families of homicide victims. This includes assistance with funerals, explanations of trial proceedings and referrals to available services.
- Family Justice Center: co-locating police investigative units with agencies that offer victim and survivors a full array of support and services in one location.
- BEST clinicians: partnership with BMC's Boston Emergency Services Team (BEST); placing BEST clinicians in district stations to improve response to emotionally disturbed persons (EDPs).
- Street Outreach Team: This two person team formed in August 2008 works with homeless and service providers to prevent crime, reduce disorder and improve quality of life for homeless, chronic substance abusers, individuals with mental illness.
- North Star Personal Alert Program: This is a voluntary program formed in 2011 for parents, guardians or caretakers of children and individuals that may have a tendency to wander or are a flight risk from a specific location (home, school, nursing home etc.). The program is designed to help individuals that may have a difficult time communicating with First Responders and, in some cases, do not understand the potential danger he/she may be in. This Program is geared towards, but not limited to, children/individuals with Autism/Autistic Spectrum Disorders and individuals with Alzheimer's disease.

Youth Programs:

- Boston Police Teen Academy Celebrating its fifth year, the Police Teen Academy is directed and operated by the Boston Police Academy during the summer. The Police Teen Academy helps the students connect with the police officers in their community, while also building character and learning life skills. Conflict resolution is a major focus. All students are in need of a summer job, and benefit from the minimum wages earned for their program attendance each week. The students receive gift cards provided by local businesses such as Target and Staples that help with the purchase of back- to-school clothes and supplies. During the six week program, approximately 60 students participate in regular exercise regimens, public speaking experiences, community service efforts, and cooperatively learned to construct a bathroom from supplies donated from Home Depot.
- P.A.L. to PALS is a monthly visit by Boston Police Department personnel to local Boys and Girls Clubs in Boston. The monthly visits will be two dimensional: one part learning and interactive, the other part physical exercise. Each month, a different unit from the Boston Police Department will visit a different Boys and Girls Club site. The unit will speak on a topic related to their unit of assignment (Drug Unit drugs, Gang Unit gangs, etc.). Each visit will be scheduled for 90 minutes: Part lecture/dialogue and the other part physical (Officers playing basketball or other sport with the kids).

- Youth dialogues: facilitated sessions to break down walls between youth and police. BPD partners with NAFI, Teen Empowerment, Roxbury Youthworks and the YWCA.
- Boston Police Explorers Program: a career exploration program partnership between the BPD and the Boy Scouts of America. The program is open to young men and women between the ages of 14 and 20 with an interest in learning more about careers in the field of Law Enforcement. The program provides career orientation experiences, leadership opportunities, and community service activities.
- Boston Police Tennis Program/Volley Against Violence: a comprehensive program
 of free tennis for youth and adults of all ages, together with leadership workshops and conflict
 resolution training for boys and girls ranging in age from 4 to 17, held at Sportsmen's Tennis &
 Enrichment Center, on Blue Hill Avenue in Dorchester.
- Big Sister Association's Big for a Day Program: The Boston Police Academy hosts Big for a Day Big Sisters. The BFAD was developed to match "little sisters" between the ages of 7-15 with adult women. The "little sisters" come from diverse backgrounds and are mainly from the neighborhoods of Roxbury, Dorchester, and Mattapan. Over the course of the day, Boston police personnel and the girls participated in a variety of police-related activities.
- Boston Area Church League/ Boston Red Sox Foundation in Community Partnership: 45 youth
 to Cooperstown for Pedro Martinez' induction ceremony on 7/26; numerous city youth to Red
 Sox games throughout the summer; and Boston Historical Black College Legacy Showcase
 weekend with highlight being game at Fenway between Florida A&M and North Carolina Central
 in the spring.
- Police referrals to the **Mayor's Summer Jobs Program** which seeks to provide 10,000 youth per summer with meaningful employment, partnering with the private sector.
- Police referrals of kids to free or reduced price summer camps at partner agencies, i.e. YMCA, Boys & Girls Clubs, BCYF.

Community Engagement:

- Peace Walks with clergy and other community partners in neighborhoods most impacted by violence. These took place daily in August and September, and will be continuing twice per a week through end of November.
- Commissioner Evans created a **Social Justice Task Force**, comprised of community leaders and advocates to advise him on ways to improve the department and strengthen community trust.
- Each of the eleven police districts run community outreach and youth activities through their **Community Service Offices.** These include various annual events such as Halloween and

Christmas parties, Senior Citizens Ball, and Thanksgiving turkey give-aways; as well as sports leagues, arts programs, youth/police dialogues, community service projects and block parties. Each district also runs a Jr. Police Academy during the summer, and participates in neighborhood walks, safety briefings, neighborhood watch, and collaborations with their local non-profit and faith-based partners.

- o Jr. Police Academy
- Neighborhood movie nights and cookouts
- Flashlight walks
- "Coffee with a Cop"
- Youth / police dialogues
- National Night Out
- Neighborhood Watches
- o Family Appreciation Day
- o Father's Day Walk
- Operation Hoodsie Cup: The BPD utilized a refurbished ice cream truck to deliver free "hoodsie cups" to children and community residents in city neighborhoods, many times in conjunction with other ongoing activities and events.
- Strong Social Media presence per Office of Media Relations/ BPDNEWS (blog, Facebook, Instagram and Twitter).

Training:

- Training of recruit officers includes interaction with a community partners panel, community service projects, community policing case studies, trauma training and procedural justice.
 Beginning with the recruit class that started in December, an extra week of training has been added in order to expand the one day community service work to a full week.
- Bias-Free Policing Elearning course is mandated for veteran officers' in-service training.

Related Federal Initiatives:

- The BPD has very strong relationships with other city departments in coordinated efforts to reduce youth violence and provide services and opportunities to youth and families Mayor's Office of Public Safety Initiatives, Boston Centers for Youth and Families, Youth Options Unlimited, Boston Public Health Commission, and Boston Public Schools. Currently BPD is the lead agency in the City of Boston's participation in the Obama Administration's National Forum on Youth Violence Prevention. Boston is one of the six original cities selected in 2010 for participation in this learning community of federal agencies and 14 other cities from across the country.
- BPD runs two federally funded reentry programs Boston Reentry Initiative that targets the highest risk inmates returning from the Suffolk County House of Corrections, providing them

with case management and supports. And Overcoming the Odds, which does the same for those returning from the Department of Correction.

- BPD is the lead agency in the *Community Based Violence Prevention Demonstration Program* a federally funded multi-agency initiative that provides Violence Interrupters, community mobilization and targeted intervention in Mattapan.
- Boston is a *Defending Childhood Initiative Site*. Led by the Boston Public Health Commission, this DOJ funded project focuses on identification, prevention and treatment to children exposed to violence. Massachusetts is one of three states creating a statewide DCI plan Boston representatives are part of the planning team.
- Boston is participating in My Brother's Keeper, President Obama's initiative to improve life
 outcomes for Black and Latino youth and young adults, specifically: graduating from high school
 ready for college and career, successfully entering the workforce, reducing youth violence, and
 providing a second chance.

Other Collaborations:

- BPD is the lead agency in the state-funded Shannon Community Safety Initiative a multiagency initiative that provides targeted services and interventions for at-risk/ gang involved youth from 5 hotspot locations.
- BPD is the lead agency, with the Boston Public Health Commission, in the state funded Safe and Successful Youth Initiative – a multi-agency initiative that intervenes with those most likely to use firearms.
- BPD is a member, along with the Boston Public Health Commission and Boston Public Schools, in the advisory board for the Youth Violence Prevention Funders Learning Collaborative. This collaborative aligns funders to focus investments and track outcomes in targeted areas and strategies.

Boston Regional Intelligence Center (BRIC):

- BRIC is an award winning Fusion Center and an invaluable tool for the Boston Police Department
 and the Metro region. BRIC serves as the central point for the collection, synthesis, analysis and
 dissemination of strategic and tactical intelligence to law enforcement, intelligence, first
 responder and private sector partners; and to assist the federal government as a partner for
 national security.
- In addition, BRIC houses the **Real Time Crime Center**, **ShotSpotter** (acoustic gun detection technology), and links to the Probation Department's **GPS monitoring system**.


